I am requesting funding for the San Leandro Shoreline Development Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of San Leandro, located at 835 East 14<sup>th</sup> Street, San Leandro, CA 94577. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve storm water, drinking water, recycled water, and wastewater systems in this area. The project would eliminate extensive paved surfaces and replace much of the area with park and green infrastructure that will vastly improve runoff from storm water and prevent the contamination of the wastewater system. The City will address risks to both public health and the environment by improving water quality and mitigating sea level rise.

The funding would be used to create a regional park along the East Bay shoreline with investments in clean water infrastructure and new recreation opportunities for residents. This would allow the city to improve wastewater and stormwater infrastructure at the site to protect the public health of constituents and the environment and aquatic resources along the watershed.
