Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Public Safety Equipment for Regional Integration in Fiscal Year (FY) 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Emeryville, located at 1333 Park Avenue, Emeryville, CA 94608.

The funding would be used to enhance the City of Emeryville's regional public safety coordination through investments in a mobile command center, deployable emergency scene equipment and integrated incident management software, allowing the Emeryville Police Department to connect with law enforcement partners in Alameda County and the broader region.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve the effectiveness of law enforcement by enhancing regional public safety coordination through strategic investments in interoperable public safety equipment and communication technologies.
