I am requesting funding for the East Bay Regional Fire Training in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Albany, located at 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, CA 94706.

The funding would be used to support the construction of the East Bay Regional Fire Training Facility, which would serve Northern Alameda and Western Contra Consta County first responders with a facility that will become an Accredited Local Academy through the State Fire Marshall.
