Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Alameda Point Stormwater Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers located at 450 Golden Gate Ave, 4th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94102.

The funding would be used to complete design and environmental clearance activities for a critical infrastructure project. This project will stabilize the northern shoreline and construct two new stormwater outfalls that will connect to the Inner Harbor storm drain system and a levee to ensure flood resilience in the area between the Main Street Ferry Terminal and the former Naval Air Station Alameda runways.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it protects public safety by reducing flood hazards and safeguarding the Main Street Ferry Terminal, a critical piece of transportation infrastructure for the region. At \$1.78 million, this upfront investment for a federally authorized \$30 million project would support the long-term redevelopment of a former Naval Air Station into a productive community asset.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 219(f)(445) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1992, as amended by Public Law 118-272.
